Young Eagles News -

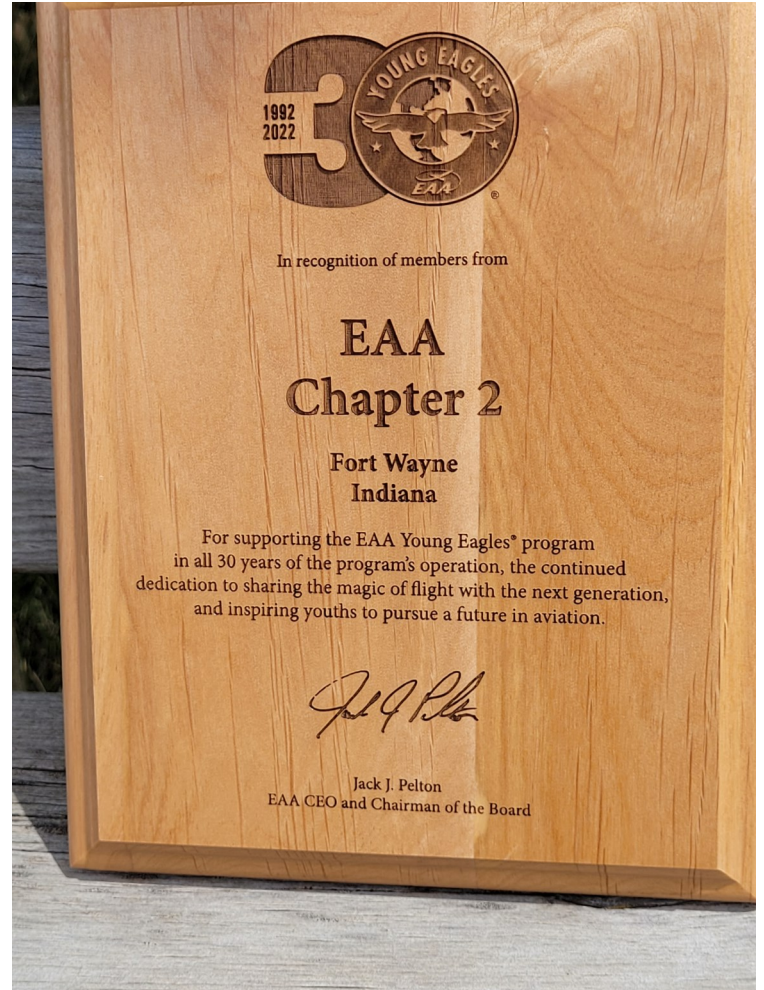
